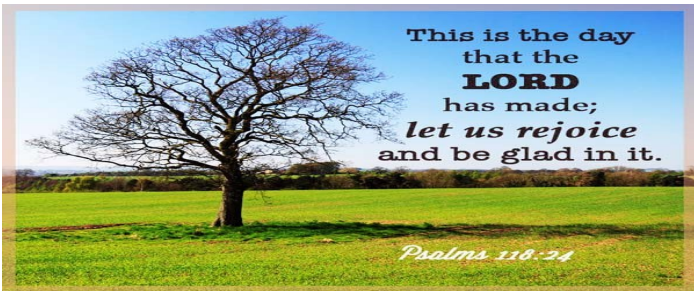
**PARISH COUNCIL/FINANCE COUNCIL:** Our next meeting will be today, Sunday, July 24th right after Mass.
