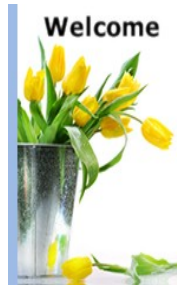

This year's Men's Conference speakers will be Dr. Ray Guarendi and Fr. John Lager. Dr. Ray is a clinical psychologist, author, professional speaker, and national radio and television host. His radio show, "The Dr. Is In" can be heard on over 440 stations and Sirius XM channel 130. His TV show, "Living Right with Dr. Ray" is aired in 140 countries. Fr.
