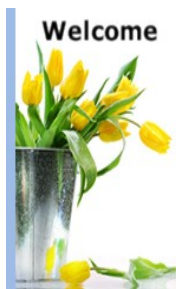
Children Question: Jesus tells us not to be afraid. Name a time when you were afraid and Jesus helped you out?
