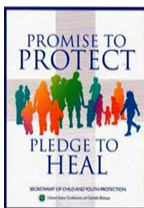
FREE CHRISTMAS GIFT: If you didn't receive a Christmas gift from the church at the Christmas Eve Mass, please pick up your gift in the back of church!
