RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: Our next Rel. Ed. Class will be Sunday, April 8th. Have a great Spring Break and a Blessed Easter!

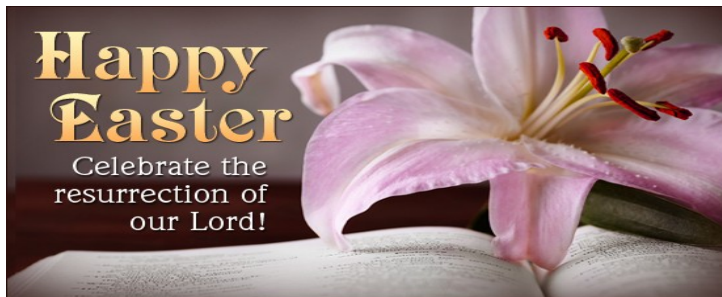
YOGA: Yoga for March are the following dates: April 5th, 12th, 19th and the 26th.
