 Amen.

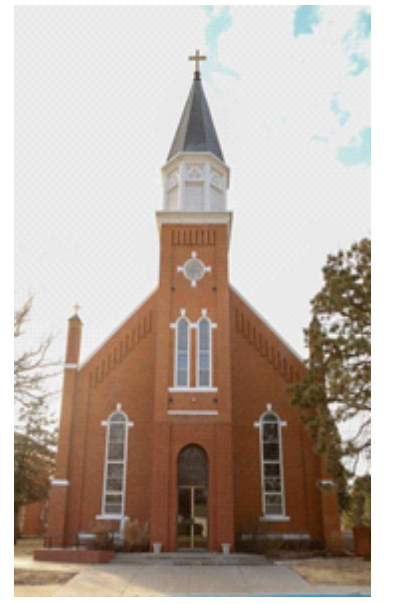
