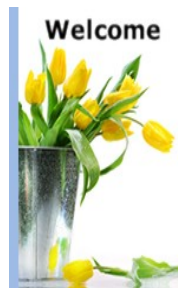
**Children Question:** Jesus showed that he loved Zacchaeus by having supper with him. How does Jesus show his love for you?
