Theme: Jesus, our cornerstone.

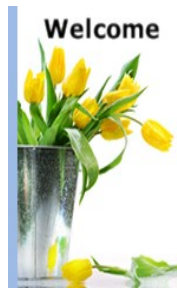
Adult Question: How are the promises of this Gospel passage made real in your own life? How do you experience yourself doing greater works than even Jesus did?

AUG. 12: The sixth annual Diocesan Catholic Men's Conference is Saturday, August 12 at Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish in Hays. This year's Men's Conference speakers will be Dr. Ray Guarendi and Fr. John Lager. Dr. Ray is a clinical psychologist, author, professional speaker, and national radio and television host. His radio show, "The Dr. Is In" can be heard on over 440 stations and Sirius XM channel 130. His TV show, "Living Right with Dr. Ray" is aired in 140 countries. Fr. John is a well-known Capuchin Friar and native of Angelus, Kansas. He has served as the national chaplain of FOCUS since 2013. In addition, he has functioned in a wide variety of ministries within the Capuchin Order; was the executive director of the Samaritan House of Denver; and is cofounder of the international men's ministry Marked Men for Christ.
