**Adult Question:** Tell about your experiences of hearing god speak in “tiny voices” rather than in the winds and earthquakes of life.

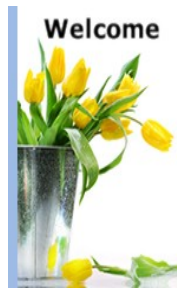
