**Catholic Home Mission Appeal:** The annual Catholic Home Mission Appeal benefits the Salina Diocese as well as 89 other dioceses in the US. In 2017, the \$50,000 received helped with seminarian education which costs the diocese around \$400,000 per year, Hispanic ministry, and higher education for two priests which included Fr. Peter O'Donnell who was studying for Canon Law degree.

This year the appeal will provide \$9 million for the mission dioceses. The principal focus is: 1. Evangelization activities; 2. Religious Education; 3. Ministry training for priest, deacons, religious sisters & brothers and lay people; and 4. support our poor parishes across the country. Thank you for your generosity - collection is next Sunday.
